We've also practised touching the objects and saying the number at the same time we touch to make sure we are being accurate and exploring the different things that we can count.

Homework



Speaking and Listening

This is one of the most important areas of learning for the Early Years. The children have been practising their listening skills through playing games, circle time activities and copying rhythms. This important skill will really help the children develop as readers and writers.

Next week we will be talking about our families and who is in our family. Over the weekend please talk to your child about your family, getting them to share their ideas of family with you too.
