Topic.

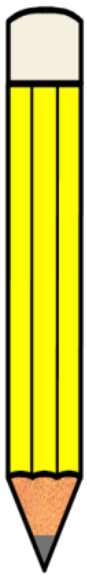
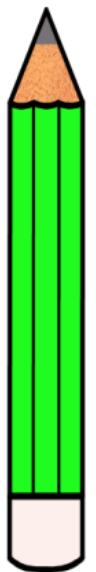
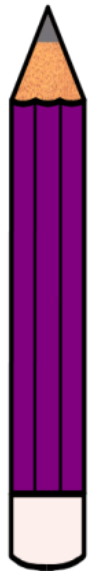
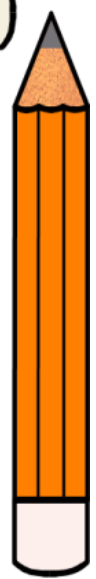
In topic, we are learning about an ancient civilisation known as the Indus Valley. We will be locating this lost civilisation on maps and identifying what continent it is a part of. Using enquiry based learning and debating techniques, we will try to answer questions about why it was abandoned.

Maths.

In maths, we are learning about place value and from this we will be comparing and ordering numbers. We are then moving on to adding and subtracting numbers mentally and beginning to look at how we can do this using a written method. We are also practising our times tables regularly.

Science.

In science, we are focussing on animals including humans. This means we will be learning about nutrition and different parts and functions of the body. We will also construct food chains whilst identifying the producers, prey and predators.
