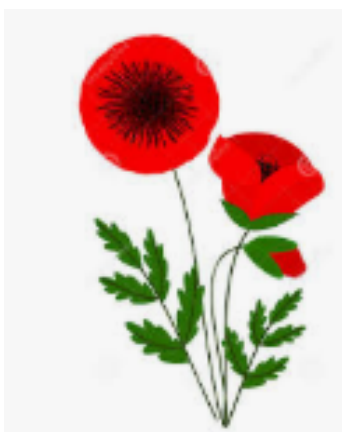
Friday 16th November - Celebration Assembly
