School Closed and Remote Learning

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this message finds you well. I am writing to share with you some remote learning activities that will support your child in engaging with their education while the school is closed. It is important that we continue to foster their educational development during this time, and your involvement will be invaluable in helping them stay on track.

To assist with this, I have listed some learning activities that can be completed at home. Please find below the suggested tasks and/or online links for your child to work on today:

In writing, we are learning to use time adverbials such as *first, next, then, after, this morning* and *finally*. Ask your child to think about what they did this morning and tell you in full sentences using time adverbials to show the order of events. You can then challenge them to write them in a sentence or draw a picture of each event and tell you verbally.

Find 10 small objects around the house e.g. coins, dry pasta, etc. Ask your child to split the objects into two groups in different ways and record what they find. They can do this by telling you e.g. *7 and 3 make 10* or they can write it down as a number sentence (e.g. $3 + 7 = 10$).
