Free Eye Screening for All Pupils

We are pleased to share that we have arranged **free electronic eyesight screening** for every child in school. This quick, non-invasive process uses specialist equipment to help identify any undiagnosed vision difficulties that may affect reading, concentration, or confidence.

- No eye drops, discomfort or reading required
- Suitable for pupils from **Reception to Year 6**
- Screening will take place **during the school day**
- A consent letter will be sent home **after half-term**
- Results will indicate whether a follow-up optician appointment is recommended

This screening does not replace a full eye test, but it does support early identification. Participation is optional and requires parental/career consent.
