

Home Challenge

This term's theme is "Superheroes".
Superhero stories are often told in comics.

Can you draw a short comic strip to tell a story about your favourite superhero, or a superhero you have made up yourself?

English

To explore our superhero topic we will be reading *Superworm* by Julia Donaldson and discussing comic books and other superhero stories. We will be focusing on Phonics to aid reading and spelling. We will be learning sentence structure and punctuation.

Art.

We will be looking at pictures by famous artists to help us make self-portraits.

Maths

In maths we will be working on counting fluently forwards and backwards up to 100 and learning to count in twos, fives and tens.

We will be practising our number formation and working on our number bonds to 10 and 20.

Science

Our science topic this term is 'Animals Including Humans'. We will be learning to name the parts of the human body and discussing how to look after our bodies.

We will also learn about the 5 senses and doing practical experiments to explore them.
