We are pleased to let you know that our school has been successful in its recent application to join the Government's **Free Breakfast Club Programme**. This national initiative supports schools across the country in providing a free, universal breakfast offer for all primary-aged children, from **Reception through to Year 6**.

From **2nd September 2026**, we will begin offering this **FREE Breakfast Club** to all pupils.

To ensure the provision runs smoothly, safely, and in line with national funding requirements, we kindly ask all families to follow the terms and conditions below:

- **All Breakfast Club places must be booked in advance via ParentPay.**
This helps us to manage numbers, staffing, and food preparation.
- **Breakfast Club will run from 8:00am to 8:40am.**
This is the full session time funded through the National Free Breakfast Programme.
- **Children are expected to attend the full 40-minute session.**
Partial attendance is not permitted under government guidelines.
- **Pupils must arrive promptly at 8:00am.**
To avoid disruption and ensure fairness, children will not be admitted after 8:00am.

These expectations help us maintain a calm, safe, and well-organised start to the day for all pupils. We appreciate your support in following these procedures.
