



*This is the sixth and final leaflet in the series being sent home each week. This leaflet is designed to help extend children's understanding when reading.*

*The following questions are higher order questions; they will help your child to give their opinion – their personal view / judgement of what they have read.*

*It is always good to discuss the story with your child.*

*Give your child the time and opportunity to talk about the story, what they think about it as whole and certain elements.*

*Always give your child the chance to say why they think that.*

*Your child should use examples from their reading book to answer these questions. Before you begin discuss the meaning of the word 'opinion'.*

*What is your opinion of your book?*

*Does your opinion of a character change during the story? Why?*

*Why do you think (the boy / girl) behaved that way?*

*What do you think will happen next? Why?*

*Do you think this story is similar to any other that you have read?*

*Which stories were similar and how are they similar?*

*If you could re-write the ending of the story how would you change it?*

*Why?*
