This is a fantastic opportunity to ensure children start the day with a healthy meal and a calm, positive transition into learning. See below an update we have so far.

Booking Arrangements

To enable us to plan staffing and food provision effectively, all places must be booked at least one week in advance. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate pupils who simply turn up on the day. More information on how to book will follow shortly.

Arrival Expectations

Breakfast Club will begin promptly at 8:00am.

Due to Local Authority requirements, all children must arrive on time and are expected to attend for a minimum of 30 minutes.

This provision is not an early drop-off service
 Late arrivals may not be admitted

Food Provision

A range of healthy breakfast options will be available each morning, including:

Cereals
 Porridge
 Toast
 Fresh fruit
 Yogurt
 Milk and juice

Children will eat together in the school hall, in a similar way to lunchtime arrangements.
